Fieldwork is not required as part of the MS program and must be obtained independently of the program. The program will assist in locating options for such supervision. Supervised fieldwork, according to the Behavior Analyst Certification Board, Inc.® may not begin until the first course in the approved sequence (PSYC 513 or ABA 513) has been started.
